Andalucía Film Commission

Andalucía Film Commission is a nonprofit institution that aims to promote Andalusia as a place of shooting giving free assistance and supporting companies and professionals of the audiovisual industry in the logistics of their productions.

Since its inception in 1998, Andalucía Film Commission reports on possible locations in Andalusia and coordinates the audiovisual industry and production companies with the government, performing a work directed to attracting tourism and therefore creating a beneficial economic impact in the Andalusian region.

It also has signed agreements with public and private institutions from different provinces of Andalusia to create the Film Cities Network, providing the best coverage of audiovisual production needs throughout Andalusia.

Tax Incentives

International Productions



Tax Incentives. Up to 30%

- 30% Tax rebate of the first million
- 25% for the rest of the expenditure made in Spain



Rebate limit. €1 - € 10 million

- The maximum rebate limit is 20 million euros for feature films and 10 million euros for TV series (per episode)
- Minimum expense incurred in Spain: €1 million (€ 200.000 for animation and VFX)



Beneficiaries

Producers registered in the Registry of Cinematographic Companies of the Institute of Cinematography and Audiovisual Arts of Spain.



Eligible expenses

- The expenses of creative staff, with tax residence in Spain or in a member state of the European Economic Area.
- The expenses derived from the use of technical industries and other suppliers.



Tax Incentives

National Productions and Coproductions

- Spanish investments in film and audiovisual production are often carried out via an EIG (Economic Interest Grouping) which is set up as the film's producer. These investments give the producer the right to a tax credit of 30% of the first million Euros, and 25% if the investment is higher.
- The base for the deduction is equal to the total production cost plus the cost of copies, advertising and promotion financed by the producer (with a 40% limit of the production cost).
- The law establishes a territorial requirement and 50% of the deduction base must correspond to the expenses incurred in Spain.
- The cost of the deduction is 20 million euros for feature films and 10 million euros for TV series (per episode)
- In the case of a co-production, the amounts will be determined for each co-producer, according to their respective share-percentage of the co-production.
- The amount of this deduction, together with the rest of the aid received, may not exceed 50 percent of the cost of production. (Except in some cases established in the regulation)
- Once the film's nationality certificate has been obtained and the rest of the requirements have been fulfilled, the tax rebate can be applied for during the month of July in the year after the production end-date.





Film Cities Network

To provide the best audiovisual production's coverage, Andalucía Film Commission has signed agreements with both public and private Andalusian institutions. The result of it is the creation of the Film Cities Network, a regional network which covers the territory with physical and virtual offices.






Locations
